A rodent family multiplies exponentially. A single female mouse produces 30 to 50 offspring in a single year. The gestation period is only 42 days and a single litter can have four to 12 pinkies (pups). They reach maturity in just four months. In other words, a single pair of mice can multiply to a serious colony in a matter of a few months.

The tiny size also allows them to squeeze in through pipes, openings and cracks that are no bigger than the size of your thumb. They also damage sewage lines, water pipes, etc.

You think you have sealed all the entry points. These rodents can still find a way to inside your house, in spite of all your attempts to keep them out.
